You can help document historic sites using photogrammetry and XR tools!

You can also participate in humanities research by exploring artworks, researching their histories, and writing descriptions or articles for the Tanit XR website, helping make cultural heritage more accessible to global audiences.



Our founder, Ines Said, is a Tunisian XR developer who takes inspiration from the goddess Tanit as she works to preserve the historic ruins she grew up loving.

We train volunteers in Tunisia in photogrammetry skills to capture scans on the ground, and then students and skilled volunteers worldwide use these scans to create a virtual museum.

If we can protect heritage in Tunisia—using immersive technology, community storytelling, and local leadership—we can build a model to safeguard cultural sites around the world.

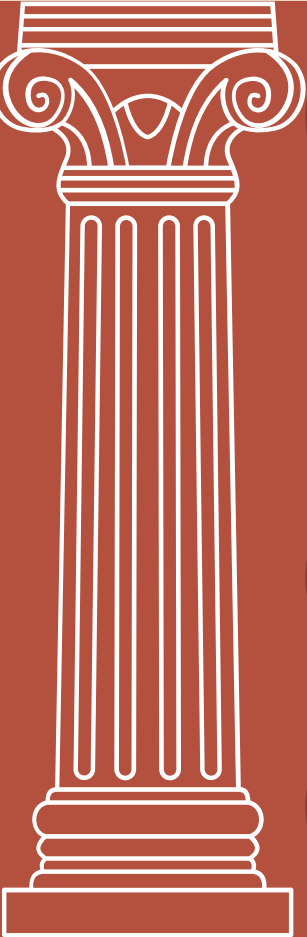
